### **Camp Eagle 2019 Policy Handbook**

It is our pleasure to welcome you to Athens Christian Camp Eagle. We are happy to have you and we hope this will be a fun and satisfying summer for you.

Please review these policies with your child(ren) and then complete and return the signature page along with your registration forms.

#### **Admission Requirements**

All necessary registration forms must be completed and returned prior to admission. It is the parent's responsibility to ensure all forms are updated immediately upon changes. Upon arrival at Camp Eagle the parent, or adult dropping off the child, must escort the child into the building, sign the check-in form, and ensure that a staff member is aware of the child's presence.

A non-refundable registration fee of \$75 is due upon enrollment.

Camp fees of \$150/week (\$135/2<sup>nd</sup> child, \$120/3<sup>rd</sup> child) will be due each Monday morning upon arrival or first day of camp for the week.

There will be no admittance without payment.

Returned checks will incur a fee of \$25 in addition to your bank fee.

Daily rate is \$40 and must be pre-approved to ensure availability.

#### **Camp Hours**

Camp Eagle will operate from 7:30 am to 5:30 pm daily. Camp Eagle will run from Tuesday, May 28, 2019 to Wednesday, July 31, 2019 with the exception of Thursday, July 4, 2019 and Friday, July 5, 2019.

Children must be picked up no later than 5:30 pm. A late charge of \$1 per minute will be charged after 5:30 pm and will be due at the time of pick up.

## **Discipline**

The staff requests parental support in helping maintain appropriate conduct during camp, including field trips.

Children's behavior should reflect self-control, respect and consideration for the rights, feelings, and property of others. We look forward to fun activities and getting to know your child. However, if, after sufficient warnings and lesser corrections have proven ineffective, a child who continues to display an uncooperative attitude, or if at any time, a student is deemed by the administration to be a threat to the well-being of others, he/she will be asked to withdraw from Camp Eagle. This decision will only be made after prayerful deliberation and will be based on the well-being and benefit for all students.

## **Dress Code**

We want our kids to be cool and comfortable during the summer. Therefore both girls and boys may wear fingertip length shorts. Sleeveless shirts and tank tops with two inch straps are acceptable. Comfortable shoes, preferably tennis shoes, are strongly suggested as students will be playing outside. Cool summer dresses are welcome with bike shorts underneath. Jeans, pants, and capris may also be worn.

## **Electronic Devices**

Gaming devices, iPod, Mp3's, radios, or any similar device are permitted at certain times during the day.

All cell phones must be kept turned off and in book bags during camp hours unless permission is granted by a staff member. If you need to contact your child during the day, please call the office at 706-549-0580. Campers are not permitted to use social media during camp hours. ACS is not responsible for lost or broken items.

## **Field Trips**

Properly supervised and planned field trips are a fun part of our program. A transportation permission form must be signed for each trip. Field trips may require an additional fee and may include eating lunch at a restaurant.

## **Health Requirements**

All campers must have a current immunization record on file before attending camp.

Sick policy: We will adhere to the current communicable disease chart of recommendations for exclusion of sick children from the center as well as their readmission. Your child will need to refrain from attending camp with the following symptoms:

Cough – lasting more than one week

Diarrhea – 3 or more watery stools in a 24 hour period

Fever – temperature of 100 degrees F (orally) or higher

Lice/Scabies – Children must not return to camp until they are free of lice and nits (eggs). Children with scabies can be admitted after treatment with documentation.

Nasal discharge – greenish and lasting more than one week

Pink eye - teary, redness of eyelid lining, irritation followed by swelling and yellow drainage

Rash – body rash, especially with fever or itching, Heat rashes and allergic reactions are not contagious.

Sore throat – especially with a fever or swollen glands

Vomiting – within the past 24 hours

## **Meals**

Campers need to bring their own lunch and drink. Afternoon snack is provided.

Breakfast/morning snack may be brought, if desired, and eaten between 7:30 and 8:30 am.

Field trips may include eating lunch at a restaurant.

## **Medication**

Campers needing prescribed medications should take the medications at home, if possible. However, if medication must be given at camp, it must be accompanied by completed medication authorization form. Please ask for one in the office if needed.

## **Personal Belongings**

Please put your child's name on all sweaters, jackets, raincoats, book bags, and other personal articles. ACS is not responsible for lost items.

## **Visits to Campus**

For security reasons, we ask ALL visitors to report to the kindergarten building/Camp Eagle office. **We sincerely ask that everyone please cooperate regarding visitations.**
