

2021-2022 Athens Christian Middle/High School Dress Code



BOYS AND GIRLS (Monday - Thursday):

- School uniform pant or uniform short (khaki, grey, black)
may be purchased anywhere school uniforms are sold
****Pants may not be denim, knit material, or leggings***
****Shorts no shorter than 3" above the knee***
- Collared Shirt - polo shirts, button up oxford (small brand logo or ACS logo only)
- Sweatshirts and hoodies (ONLY ACS logos/branded) No non-ACS sweatshirts or hoodies inside or outside during academic hours.
- Winter coats and raincoats do not require a logo but may not be worn in the building.

GIRLS ADDITIONAL OPTIONS:

- Skirts/Dresses (knee length)
 - Capris (khaki, grey, black)
 - Blouses and tops
- *no spaghetti or tank straps (tops must have full sleeveless coverage), no see through material, bare midriff, or immodestly low cut tops
*pants may not be denim, knit material, or leggings

PE: (Boys and Girls...6th-12th grade)

- Mandatory PE uniforms must be worn during all Physical Education classes
- May be purchased at the school store or online via the school website
- An ACS logo/brand hoodie may be worn when outside on cold days. No other outerwear is permitted during physical education classes.
- Appropriate athletic (tennis) shoes must be worn at all times during Physical Education.

HIGH SCHOOL WEIGHT TRAINING: (Boys and Girls)

- Students participating in high school weight training will either purchase and wear a PE uniform OR wear team issued practice gear that is still in good repair.

FRIDAY OPTION:

- ACS spiritwear t-shirts may be worn by ALL students / boys shirts tucked in and belt worn
- Same guidelines for bottoms as Monday-Thursday

SHOES:

- Middle/High School students will wear closed toe, school appropriate footwear. • Girls may wear sandals, no flip flops.

HAIR:

- Hair should be neatly groomed and styled (not in eyes). The administration has full discretion to determine "neatly groomed and styled."
- Hair for both boys and girls must be of a natural hair color
- Boys must be clean-shaven and hair must be worn without restraints.

OTHER (boys and girls):

- No piercings (other than earrings for girls)
- No visible tattoos
- No hats, caps, or other head cover worn inside
- No visible necklaces for boys

INFRACTIONS:

Proper dress code attire is considered a student's "ticket to class."

If a student is out of dress code at **any time of the day** the following will occur:

- Students will be sent to the Office with a Dress Code Note.
- Depending on the item needed to correct the dress code infraction, the following will be available to the student and required:
 1. Purple ACS polo at the cost of \$20.00
 2. Khaki uniform pants at the cost of \$20.00
 3. ACS hoodies at the cost of \$20.00
 4. Belts at the cost of \$10.00
- These items will be required to correct dress code issues and charges will be placed on the student's FACTS account (to be paid within 30 days).

Extra-curricular activities: Jeans and t-shirts in good repair may be worn for athletic or outdoor spectator events. School dress code is appropriate for fine arts events. PE or team issued shorts should be worn for practices and after school events. **Boys are expected to wear a shirt at all times on campus.**
